

TUBERVILLE BUDGET RESOLUTION AMENDMENTS

Introduced February 3, 2021

- 1. Funding for Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities Transfer \$5 billion currently allocated to institutions of higher education to nursing homes and assisted living communities. (TAM21261 N80)
- 2. Funding for Nursing Homes and Assisted Living Facilities Transfer \$5 billion currently allocated for state and local assistance to nursing homes and assisted living communities. (TAM21276 3SP)
- 3. **Support for Rural Broadband** Transfer \$10 billion currently allocated for state and local assistance to support for rural broadband. (RYA21111 XTJ)
- 4. **Support for Rural States to Combat COVID** States with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated to facilitate and support COVID-19 vaccination, testing, and containment efforts. (GOE21130 NN3)
- 5. **Funding for Rural States to Support Reopening Schools** States with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated to support the reopening of elementary and secondary schools. (AEG21110 47X)
- 6. **Funding for Rural States to Support Small Businesses** States with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated for small business grants. (MIR21120 1PY)
- 7. **Funding to Support Rural State and Local Governments** States with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated to support state and local governments. (GOE21131 900)
- 8. **Funding for Rural States to Support Infrastructure** States with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated to support public transit and may use the funds for the purpose of repairing aging infrastructure. (OLL21157 TJW)

- 9. **Funding for Rural States to Support Higher Education** Colleges and universities located in states with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated to the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund. (BOM21117 GJN)
- 10. **Funding for Rental Assistance in Rural States** Landlords operating rental housing in states with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated for rental assistance. (MIR21121 7JC)
- 11. **Funding for Rural States to Support Child Care** Child care providers operating in states with a FY 2021 nonurban area Medicare wage index of 0.805 or below shall receive, at a minimum, 30 percent of all funds appropriated for the child care emergency stabilization fund. (KIN21080 T48)
- 12. Funding to Support Reopening of Schools Primary and secondary schools that receive funds or other aid to support their reopening must offer in-person learning that is consistent with local health conditions. (AEG21111 8FX)
- 13. Funding to Support Reopening of Schools Primary and secondary schools that receive funds or other aid to support their reopening must require teachers and staff to return to in-person academic instruction following their vaccination. (BOM21120 Y9W)
- 14. **Preventing Funding from Going to Illegal Aliens** Only American citizens may be eligible to receive a direct aid or stimulus payment. (MDM21184 GTC)
- 15. **Protecting American Workers** To establish a deficit-neutral reserve fund to ensure that the United States will not negotiate or support treaties or trade agreements that negatively affect American worker pay, protections, and employment opportunities. (ROS21172 W4G)
- 16. **Protecting the Unborn by Prohibiting Funding for Abortion** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund relating to prohibiting federal funding for abortion services. (BAI21111 2M6)
- 17. **Protecting U.S. Telecom Supply Chain from China** To create a point of order against any legislation that is a subsequent action of permitting Huawei and its non-U.S. affiliates back into the U.S. supply chain. (ROS21173 6L3)
- 18. **Securing the Border** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund authorizing the expenditure of funds previously appropriated for border wall construction. (MDM21182 0M3)

- 19. **Funding for Rural Broadband** To establish a deficit-neutral reserve fund to expand and strengthen broadband access to rural health centers, as well as public schools. (TAM21264 VYC)
- 20. **Fighting Sanctuary Cities** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund recognizing that enforcement and removal officers are authorized to enforce immigration laws throughout the United States, including sanctuary jurisdictions and other safe haven carve outs. (MDM21183 MH0)
- 21. **Preventing Illegal Aliens from Getting Vaccines** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund relating to allocating federally-funded COVID-19 vaccinations for U.S. citizens and legal residents. (TAM21265 FCT)
- 22. **Protecting Small Business** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund to protect small businesses from the economic effects of COVID-19. (MIR21119 3R6)
- 23. **Protecting Women's Athletics** To establish a deficit neutral reserve fund to prohibit federal funds to institutions that permit biological males to participate in athletic programs for women and girls. (MCC21097 NH4)
