Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PARTICIPATION OF MALES IN

ATHLETIC PROGRAMS OR ACTIVITIES AT THE

MILITARY SERVICE ACADEMIES THAT ARE

DESIGNATED FOR WOMEN OR GIRLS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall
