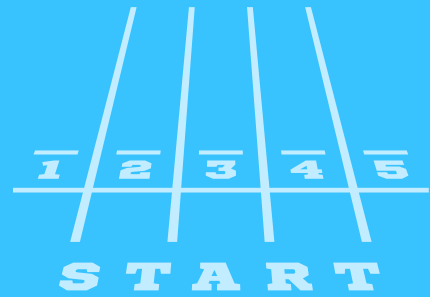


COACH TUBERVILLE

CHAMPIONS WOMEN'S SPORTS



Since the enactment of **Title IX 51 years ago**, female participation in college sports has **increased sevenfold**, giving scholarships and opportunities to **thousands of women** across America.

But today the **Biden administration is waging war on women's sports** by all-but-requiring schools to let **boys play in women's sports**.

Coach Tommy Tuberville's (R-AL) 40-year coaching career started with junior girls' basketball. Title IX had recently been implemented, and Coach saw firsthand the **difference it made in the lives of young female athletes**.

That's why **Coach Tuberville is leading the fight to save women's sports in the U.S. Senate**.

What Coach is doing:

Sponsoring the [Protection of Women and Girls in Sports Act](#)

- Coach's bill would **cut funding for schools that allow boys to compete against girls**.
- Ensures Title IX provisions define gender as **"based solely on a person's reproductive biology and genetics at birth."**

Putting Democrats on record voting against protecting women

- Offered an [amendment](#) to **protect Title IX** as part of Democrats' \$1.9 trillion stimulus bill. Senate Democrats blocked it 49-50.
- One week after the House passed Coach's legislation, Coach went to the Senate floor and asked for unanimous consent to pass the bill.
- Zero Democrats in the House voted for the bill and Senator Mazie Hirono blocked unanimous consent, effectively putting a hold on the bill.

Holding the Biden Administration accountable

- Coach Tuberville **led a group of 21 Senators in issuing a clear [rebuke](#) to Education Secretary Miguel Cardona's proposed changes to Title IX**.
- [Challenged](#) Biden's Undersecretary of Education Nominee on Title IX.
- Wrote a [letter](#) to Biden's Education Secretary Miguel Cardona warning about the **dangers of allowing men to compete in women's sports**.
